Turnout: Single, Pairs, Multiples

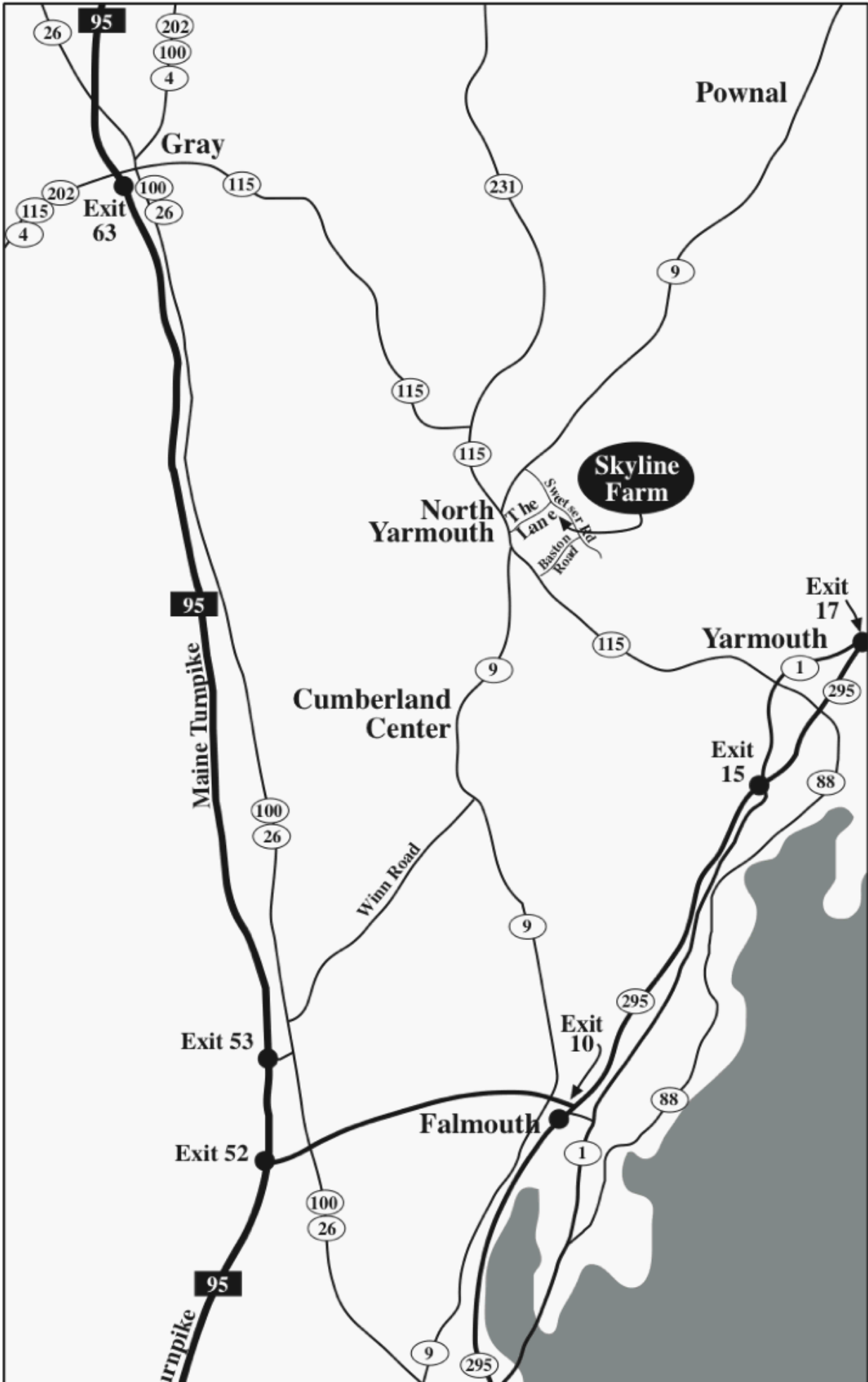
Fees: There is no entry fee. Donations to Skyline Farm will be greatly appreciated.
